With Pitz Quattrone

The Didgeridoo/Yidaki from Arnhemland, Australia has taken Central Vermonter, Pitz Quattrone from the Arctic Circle to the Equator performing, recording and passing on his knowledge of this ancient wind instrument. His deep felt connection to the Didgeridoo combined with his eagerness to pass on what he has learned, has become a mission of his life's work.

The Didgeridoo is a fun and powerful instrument to play. It also has been scientifically documented to relieve sleep apnea. Pitz, a registered teacher with the Sleep Apnea-Didgeridoo Network, will teach an evening didgeridoo class at Samara that is **open to beginners, advanced players, sleep apnea sufferers, former students, and anyone who is interested in learning to play the didge or sharpen their skills.**

Participants are welcome to bring their own didge or Pitz will have his handcrafted wooden didgeridoos starting at \$65. Class cost is \$25 per person. Space is limited, sign up early.
